Course Description: This course provides practical hands-on experience to prepare for and carry out production of all Delta theatre related presentations. This production course may involve the production and maintenance of one or more necessary theatre skills such as lighting, sound, sets, visual effects, make-up and more. This course is a lab course where students learn safe and effective technical skill through working with a production crew on various college productions.
