Section	Subject	Title Alcohol Use In/On Delta Facilities	

This policy is specifically designed to govern the use of alcohol at Delta for officially sponsored events and on/in Delta facilities/property. The serving, possessing, consuming and sale of alcoholic beverages in or on Delta-controlled facilities/properties may be done only in accordance with the provisions of state and local laws and ordinances; and LCTCS policy (4.009).

Alcoholic beverages are in general prohibited at Delta sponsored events and on or in Delta facilities/properties, except as indicated below. Alcoholic beverages are permitted on Delta facilities/properties under the following circumstances:

- 1. At officially sponsored events with prior approval of the Chancellor.
- 2. All state and local laws and ordinances must be observed and the organizer of the event is responsible for seeing that these are observed.

References:

Louisiana Revised Statute 14:93.12 states that it is unlawful for any person under twentyone (21) years of age to purchase or have public possession of any alcoholic beverages unless exempted by law.

*Louisiana Revised Statute 14:93.*13 states that it is unlawful for any person, other than a parent, spouse, or legal guardian, as specified in R.S. 14:93.10(2)(a)(ii), to purchase on behalf of a person under twenty-one years of age any alcoholic beverage.
